Before you rent your home, you may want to know:

Hunters Glen / Cove HOA welcomes long-term\*\* tenants! We will invite them to social events and include them in our distributed Newsletters, etc. (Tenants will not have access to the homeowner-protected resident/HOA information on the website.)

\*\*As of May, 2018, Hunters Glen/Cove HOA Covenants define long-term as six months or more; short-term rentals are not allowed.

Additionally, please ask your property management team to provide this information to your new tenant: <u>Who\_To\_CALL\_list.pdf (huntersglencove.com)</u> Homeowners are responsible – but the above document will give the tenant(s) emergency information, etc. that helps to protect your property.

If a situation arises that the above 'rules' are disregarded on a property, the Board will "CC" the landlord on written documents to the tenant.

The landlord/homeowner is responsible for the property and the Board will look for the landlord to remedy the situation of non-compliance within 30 days.

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
